Description

The tall back panel with skilled and well-designed stylised foliage topped by a carnation, the broad cresting with similar foliage, the back uprights with unusual delicate incised meandering scrolls and punched flowerheads, lunette-carved seat rails, columnar-turned front supports. Excellent colour and patination.
